Dear all.



BRYC (Barents Regional Youth Council) was established in 2004 to promote the interests of young people living in the Barents Region. Our mission is to strengthen people-to-people cooperation among youth and empower young people to be active participants of their societies.

BRYC's five core values are: Cooperation, tolerence, reliability, fairness and respect.

The youth council consists of 15 members from Sweden, Finland, Russia and Norway. These youths represent each of the 14 member regions of the Barents Cooperation as well as 1 person representing indigenous youth.

The council meets 2 times a year to discuss youth activities in the Barents Region, inform other representatives about the news from their regions and plan and arrange a big youth event every year.

Our main activities include the BRYC Annual Meeting (for council members) and the BRYC Annual Event (open to all youths). These activities are organized by BRYC in cooperation with various partners. Every year BRYC picks a new location for these activities.

The youth council also actively engages in other youth projects and events across the Barents Region.

BRYC is (since 2018) seen as an official member of the Barents Regional Council (BRC). This platform is our most important way of promoting youth's interests to regional and national decision makers.

BRYC's activities are funded through annual regional grants, as well as project funding. The Norwegian Barents Secretariat functions as BRYC's financial manager and youth coordinator.

To strengthen youth cooperation in the Barents Region and empower young people to be active participants of the societies in which they live.


YOUTH ISSUES

Migration continues to be a big concern when it comes to youth. A common trend in all four Barents countries is that young people leave the Barents Region, The main motives behind this youth migration is better educational and career opportunities, social connections or a warmer climate. Many of these people choose not to return after finishing their education, which causes a decline in the region's population, brain drain and a challenge to regional development. Official data shows that the region's population aged 16-29 decreased by more than half a million over the course of 27 years (1990-2017),

In the light of this development, BRYC works towards making the Barents Region more attractive for youth. Our aim is to create new opportunities within fields like culture, education, leadership, innovation, environment, health and social issues. We also want to encourage dialogue around important issues to help improve living conditions for young people in the region.

In 2019, BRYC raised awareness around three specific issues: Sexual health, equality and environment. In May, BRYC hosted a youth conference on sexual health (in Kiruna), which aimed to help improve the situation regarding sexually transmitted diseases, sexual education and sexual conduct among youth in the Barents Region. In July, BRYC organized a summer camp on female empowerment and equality (in Tromsø). For the annual event (in Vuokatti), BRYC focused on the topic of "nature vs technology", and how modern technology affects our relationship with nature.

Activity Report

2019 was a busy and eventful year for BRYC. The youth council managed to be involved in a high number of activities, extending its visibility to new audiences across the Barents region. When it comes to youth policy, BRYC promoted three main causes in 2019: Sexual health, equality and ecology. This work resulted in raised awareness around important youth issues in the Baretns Region, a policy recommendation paper on sexual health, the exchange of knowledge on equality and female empowerment, the promotion of healthy lifestyle (nature) and cultural exchange.

The youth council's goal for this year was to increase the number of activities and become more visible in the Barents Region community. More specificly, BRYC aimed to implement six predefined youth projects: "BRYC Sexual Health Conference", "Glitter: summer Camp on Female Empowerment", BRYC Annual Event 2019 "Switch", Career Development Event, Gaming Event and the "Indigenous Network" project. Perhaps a bit too ambitious, by the end of the year the council only managed to implement three of these projects, while the other three were postponed to 2020. The main reason why these projects were postponed was the limited capacity to work with the projects. BRYC also implemented another project that was not initially planned, "UnCapitals 2019". Despite these deviations from the plan, the number of projects implemented this year still exceeded the previous years'.

In addition to BRYC's own projects, the council members also attended several other Barents-related events, where they took part in plenary discussions and promoted youth's interests. Among these events were the "Workshop on digitalization of the culture sector" in Umeå, hosted by the Joint Working Group on Culture, the "Barents Forest Forum" in Umeå, hosted by the Swedish Forest Agency, and the II International Session "Cooperation in the Arctic" in Murmansk, organized by the Government of the Murmansk region with the support of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation. Another important event of 2019 was the XVII BEAC Foreign Ministers' Session in October, which concluded the Swedish Chairmanship period and launched the Norwegian Chairmanship period.

Throughout 2019, BRYC has maintained a good cooperation with the Barents Regional Council (BRC), Regional Committee (RC), and the Joint working Group on Youth (JWGY). Good relations were also maintained with the Swedish BEAC Chairmanship. In june, BRYC helped organize the Youth Follow-Up conference in Luleå by recommending panelists and youth participants. Throughout the year, BRYC also worked towards the involvement of youth in new areas of the Barents Cooperation.

Annual Meeting

The BRYC Annual Meeting 2019 was held on 14-16 February in Joensuu, Finland, back-to-back with the conference "Northern Potential in the Barents Region". The meeting elected a new Board and Chair for 2018-19. Also, a total of six new members were added to the Council. Regional reports on the youth situation were presented by each representative, and several project ideas for 2019 were presented. A total of six project ideas were supported by the council members and put up for implementation in 2019. Further details can be found in the protocol from the annual meeting.

Annual Event 2019: "Switch"

The BRYC Annual Event 2019 was held 15-18 August in Vuokatti, Finland (Kainuu region). BRYC received financial support from the Norwegian Barents Secretariat to organize the event. The region of Kainuu also provided good help with practical issues. Around 30 youths from Norway, Russia, Sweden and Finland participated in this year's event.

2019 was the UN's international year of Indigenous languages, while global warming is rapidly changing the environment and the field of technology is making steady progress. In the light of the current development, BRYC wanted to host a big youth event looking at how these changes affect us and whether we could learn something from the Indigenous philosophy of "living with the nature, and not off it". The theme of this year's annual event was therefore "nature vs technology", and the event title was "Switch", which referred to "switching on the technology versus switching it off". A large part of the event took place in the outdoors, and focused on teambuilding through physical activities such as orienteering. The event also included more educational workshops and group discussions. A more detailed report is available on BRYC's website (barentsyouth.org).













The Barents Region is vast, but the differences in regard to sexual health is small. Many youths are well aware of the lacking quality of sexual education or problems regarding binge-drinking culture that leads to borders being crossed. And the number of sexually transmitted diseases is rising once again. With an aim to adress these issues, last spring BRYC hosted a conference aiming to help improve the situation regarding sexually transmitted diseases, sexual education and sexual conduct among youth in the Barents Region. During the two-day conference held in Kiruna, Sweden, youths from across the region with personal, political or other knowledge about the subject had plenary discussions in order to create concrete and viable solutions to problems regarding sexual health in the Barents Region.

In July, BRYC teamed up with the Murmansk-based non-governmental feminist organization Koster to host a collaborative summer camp "Glitter", devoted to female empowerment and gender equality issues among youth in the Barents Region. During the three-day camp in Tromsdalen, BRYC gathered around 20 youths from across the Barents Region interested in supporting gender equality, female solidarity and an understanding of the human rights paradigm. Together, the participants took part in panel discussions and workshops devoted to these issues, as well as social and teambuilding activities.

In October, BRYC teamed up with the Murmansk-based culture organization Fridaymilk to host the fifth annual Uncapitals project. "Uncapitals: Time Shift!" was a digital art camp for youth in High North, which gathered 45 young people from the Nordic countries. Participants of the camp did research on the post-industrial community of a small Swedish town (Haparanda) in the most northern counties of Norrbotten and presented the research results on a digital web platform. #UnCapitals

INCOME

BRYC's main source of income is the annual regional grants. As agreed in the Barents Regional Council (BRC) and the Barents Regional committee (RC) in Kajaani May 2018, each region shall allocate 5000 EUR to support BRYC's meeting activities and youth event annually.


During the BRC/RC meeting in in Rovaniemi May 2018, it was decided that BRYC will be granted financial support from the member regions of the BRC over the period 2018-20. Regions that are legally prevented from allocatong such funding shall provide an inkind contribution equivalent to the same amount.

BRYC also applies for grants from other souces to cover project activities beyond the council's running costs. This year, BRYC received project grants from the Norwegian Barents Secretariat, the counties of Norrbotten and Västerbotten. as well as MUCF/Erasmus+.

EXPENSES

BRYC's expenses be divided in three main categories: 1) travel, 2) accommodation and meals, and 3) other costs (the latter including costs like remuneration fees for workshop leaders, rent of meeting premises, meeting equipment, promotional materials and unexpected costs.

Being a project grant recepient, BRYC is often expected to co-fund its projects. This cost is usually accounted for in the budget, but not limited to a specific category.





Comment:


The financial overview on page 13 shows that BRYC's actual income in 2019 is significantly lower than expected. This is not spcified in the financial report, because the annual grants are usually allocated after the annual report is written. This also implies that the full income for 2019 will be transferred in 2020.
