How to plan for a cohesive public space that binds existing architectural approaches?

- What must be considered when planning the renewal of the town center:
 - Public space must **connect** Türi's various spaces and important buildings.
 - Form a **coherent space** that stretches from the **railway station** to the **lake**.
 - The solution must not lose the **existing values and purposes** of the public space, but enrich the space with new ones with possibilities
 - The aim of the created space is to help create a **sense of place**, which would be intrinsic to Türi.

About the Architecture Competition

- Launched in June 2022 with a reward fund for competing agencies.
- In cooperation with Estonian Association of Architects.
- A panel of architects and representatives from the municipality had to choose a winner from 9 entries.
